Scotland

Highlands:

The Highlands whisky region includes the area north of an imaginary line between Edinburgh and Glasgow. It includes the "Speyside" sub-region, the area around the world's most famous salmon river, the River Spey, which is home to around 30 distilleries in a relatively small area. Highland single malt whiskies are generally rather mild and fruity. However, there are now numerous exceptions, as some distilleries deviate from their traditional methods for a few weeks a year and produce a heavily peated whisky (e.g. the Benriach distillery). The increasing experiments with different types of casks also makes it difficult to determine the taste of an entire region.

Speyside:

The Speyside region, as part of the Highlands, is the "heart of Scotch whisky production". Named after the river of the same name, the River Spey, which is also one of the most famous salmon rivers in the world, Speyside is home to the highest density of malt whisky distilleries. There are more than 30 distilleries within a radius of about 20 kilometers. In the center of this region is the small town of Dufftown with about 3,000 inhabitants, which is also known as the secret "whiskey capital of the world". However, the sentence "Rome was built on seven hills – Dufftown stands on seven stills" was only valid until the construction of the eighth distillery in Dufftown.

Campbeltown:

In the formerly very important whisky region of Campbeltown (at the southern tip of which is the Mull of Kintyre), which is located on the peninsula of the same name and was once a very important region with over 30 distilleries, 5 different single malt whiskies are currently produced in 3 distilleries. The Springbank distillery produced the Springbank of the same name, as well as Longrow and Hazelburn. The Glengyle Distillery produces Kilkerran and rounds off the selection of whiskies from the Campbeltown region by the Glen Scotia Distillery.

Lowlands:

The lightest and freshest single malt whisky in Scotland is generally produced in the Lowlands. South of the imaginary line between Glasgow and Edinburgh - where the hills are gentler and nature shows its softer side—you'll find a handful of distilleries. In addition to well-established names like Glenkinchie, Auchentoshan, and Bladnoch, several new distilleries have opened in recent years. Among the younger distilleries in the region are Kingsbarns, Annandale, and the Glasgow Distillery.

Islay:

The Hebridean island of Islay is the epitome of Scotch whisky for many whisky lovers around the world. This is where the smoky, peaty and phenolic whiskies come from, which cannot deny their origin. Since peat was the only available heating material in past centuries, it was of course also used for whisky production. The fact that some of the warehouses are located directly on the sea, due to the geographical conditions, is another important factor for the aroma of Islay whiskies.

Islands:

The islands west of Scotland are the island of Jura (distillery – Jura / whisky – Isle of Jura), Mull (distillery – Tobermory / whiskies – Tobermory and the peated variant called Ledaig) and Skye (distillery and whisky – Talisker), the island of Arran (distillery and whisky – Arran & Lagg), the island of Raasay (distillery and whisky – Isle of Raasay) and the Orkney Islands (distilleries Highland Park and Scapa with the whiskies of the same name) in the north of Scotland. Definition of the Scotch whisky industry to the Highlands. For better clarity, the "islands" represent a

separate region in our system. Each distillery has its own character due to the different geographical and climatic conditions of the respective island.

Blended:

Without the blended Scotch whisky, there would be no single malt! This sentence applies without reservation, as even today the majority of Scotch whisky is produced for blends. Resourceful Scottish colonial goods merchants such as Messrs. Walker, the Chivas Brothers or the Dewars family came up with the idea of creating their "house whisky" – they mixed (blended) malt whiskies from different distilleries with different styles and then topped them up with grain whisky. That was the birth of blended Scotch whisky. Some of these whiskies, which are still around today, have now become globally known and successful brands. And even today, the higher the proportion of malt whiskies in a blend, the higher the quality of this whisky. Blended whiskies, but in the production of which the addition of grain is completely dispensed with and for the production of which only single malt whiskies are married, are also referred to as "blended malt whisky".

Ireland:

Whiskey production in Ireland has a centuries-old tradition. In contrast to Scotch whisky, Ireland distills three times. This makes the distillate purer and lighter. The pot stills used are considerably larger than in Scotland. The mash for the Irish whiskey consists of unmalted barley, to which a small part of barley malt is added - the result is called "Pure Pot Still". After a very eventful history and the decline of the Irish whisky industry, there have been a large number of new projects and distilleries in Ireland for several years. One of the best-known projects is the Waterford Distillery, which was founded by whisky icon Mark Reynier and attaches great importance to the terroir of the barley used, working with a variety of different farms.

Canada:

All Canadian whiskies must be aged for at least 3 years in wooden casks of 700 litres or less. They must have an alcohol content of 40%, be made from grain and must have been produced in Canada. Compare that to the regulations for Scotch whisky and you'll be amazed.

Indien:

India is one of the largest whisky-producing nations in terms of volume. In the former British colony, whisky based on the Scottish model has been produced since the end of the colonial period in the 40s. Due to the prevailing climate there, the whisky matures particularly quickly and the evaporation process, the Angels Share, is many times higher than in Scotland. The most famous distillery in the country is the Amrut Distillery, which clearly stands out from the other manufacturers due to the quality of its products. Scottish barley is also partly used for production.

Japan:

The father of Japanese whisky, Masataka Taketsuru, cherished the dream of building Japan's first whisky distillery. In the years 1918-1920 he worked in various Scotch whisky distilleries and acquired his knowledge there. Since the mid-20s of the last century, single malt whisky has been produced in Japan according to the Scottish model. The two largest producers are Suntory and Nikka. Japanese whisky experienced a real boom after Jim Murray named the "Yamazaki Single Malt Sherry Cask" as the world's best whisky in 2014. Like India, most Japanese whiskies are exposed to tropical climates, so the maturation is very different from European whiskies.

Taiwan:

The taste of Taiwanese whisky is a fascinating combination of intense aromas. Characterized by a unique climate with high temperatures and high humidity, Taiwanese whiskeys are characterized by fruity notes, including peaches, apples and citrus fruits. These fresh fruit flavors are accompanied by a pleasant spice that includes spices such as ginger and cinnamon. In addition, there is a tantalizing sweetness reminiscent of caramel and honey, accompanied by subtle vanilla

notes. The rapid maturation in Taiwanese conditions gives these whiskies an amazing complexity that makes them a treat for whisky lovers around the world.

Germany:

Triggered by the "whisky boom", there are more and more master distillers in Germany who produce whisky. The history of German whisky dates back to the middle of the 20th century. With distilleries such as Elsburn, St. Kilian or Finch, there are now some German manufacturers who have brought whiskies of internationally recognized quality to the market. It will be interesting to see how German whiskies develop when they reach certain age groups. In any case, the previous qualities of young German whiskies make you want more.

Finland:

So far, Finnish whiskies have been strong, spicy and with aromas of wild honey and heather. However, there are still too few different distilleries to be able to speak of a uniform Finnish whisky style here.

America:

Bourbon:

Probably the most famous American whiskey variety is bourbon, which is named after Bourbon County in Kentucky. This "county" was named in honor of the French royal family, as Louis XVI helped the Americans during the Wars of Independence against England. By law, bourbon whiskey must be made from at least 51% corn, which gives it its typical sweet taste. The rest of the cereals used are rye, which is very spicy, mild wheat and barley, which is absolutely necessary for the fermentation process. American whiskey is mainly distilled in column stills. According to American law, bourbon must be aged in fresh, burnt-out oak barrels. The alcohol content of bourbon must not exceed 80% at the time of distillation and must not exceed 62.5% at the beginning of maturation. Bourbon is bottled with at least 40%, as brandies with a lower alcohol content may not be declared as whisky or whiskey. Theoretically, bourbon can come from all over the USA, but most bourbon distilleries are located in the US state of Kentucky. The production of bourbon is regulated by the so-called Bourbon Act of 1964. Even stricter rules apply to the Straight Bourbon and the Kentucky Straight Bourbon of the distilleries in the state of Kentucky.

Tennessee:

Tennessee whiskey is initially subject to the same requirements as bourbon whiskey. It is produced in a similar way to bourbon. Rye, corn and grain are distilled and matured in charred barrels made of new white oak. The mash bill of Tennessee whiskey must contain at least 51% corn, which is also the case with bourbon. The key difference is this: before bottling, the spirit is filtered through maple charcoal (charcoal mellowing), which makes it soft and supple as the charcoal removes pungent substances from the liquid. Mellow means 'soft' and is also referred to as charcoal mellowing. So every Tennessee whiskey is also a bourbon, but not every bourbon is also a Tennessee whiskey!

Rye:

If at least 51% rye is used in a whiskey, it may be called rye whiskey. Rye whiskey must also be matured in oak barrels. In the past, there was a large selection of rye whiskeys in America. They are characterized by an exceptionally spicy taste. However, people's tastes changed over the centuries, so that rye whiskey was almost forgotten. Because today 'mild and soft' has become fashionable. US rye whiskies are rare today, while a lot of them are still produced in Canada, as Canadian rye whiskey is an important component of Canadian blended whiskeys.

English style:

English-style rum is usually made from molasses and has a long tradition. Its taste is often described as strong and spicy. The rum owes this to the long fermentation time, its production in pot stills and the long maturation in oak barrels. The English style is mainly associated with Barbados, Belize, British Guiana, Jamaica, Mauritius, St. Lucia and Trinidad & Tobago.

French style:

The French style is mainly produced in Haiti, French Guiana, Guadeloupe, Martinique and Réunion and is also known as Rhum Agricole. This is usually distilled from sugar cane juice in column styles (with the exception of Haiti) and thus has a lighter body than conventional pot still rum. Rhum Agricole is often described as fruity-floral with a strong dry aroma at the same time.

Spanish style:

Spanish-style rum is made from molasses and distilled in column stills. The fermentation time is relatively short and the aroma is characterized by light and sweet notes. Typical countries of production of Spanish-style rum are Costa Rica, the Dominican Republic, Guatemala, Cuba, Colombia, Panama, Peru or Venezuela.
